## Be a Partner

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Dualtech Center was established in 1982 to provide skills education and values formation to the youth thereby addressing the problem of poverty.

Dualtech pioneered the Dual Training System in the Philippines adapting the German way of technical education to the local setting. The Dual-Training System Law (RA7686) fosters partnership between schools and industry. It facilitates better employment through a structured "learning while doing" approach and gives appropriate formation through cycles of theory acquisition and practice exposure.

As of 2021, Dualtech has graduated over 13,000 trainees. Among these graduates now count some entrepreneurs, some general managers, supervisors, foremen, technicians, mechanics, whom the school trained to be responsible technical professionals.

# Your company may want to partner with Dualtech by sponsoring work-trainees

We invite you to host scholars in your factories as in-plant trainees. With this, you can also fulfill your Corporate Social Responsibility program.

Partner companies may provide in-plant training up to 18 months.

To sponsor the training of a Dualtech scholar, the company funds the training subsidy per trainee per month for the school and training allowance of 75% of the applicable minimum wage for the students. Dualtech takes care of the release of stipend.

## Among the benefits of partnership are:

- Productivity and Quality training due to in-plant training exposure (familiarity with processes and products)
- Adequate evaluation period for possible future hiring or manpower pooling
- Tax incentives based on RA. 7686 or Dual Training System Act of 1994.
- Investment towards a social good

The beneficiaries are highly trainable young scholars who passed the basic training with practical hands-on exposure in laboratories and workshops. Sponsoring these trainees helps the underprivileged.

## About the course:

"Electromechanics Technology" consists of two phases.

The first phase is a 6-month basic blended learning that contains online and hands-on-training. This includes mechanical, electrical and electronics fundamentals.

The second phase is the application of training in partner companies for up to 18 months. During this phase, the scholars attend weekly mentoring sessions in Dualtech to ensure continuing values formation.

Dualtech advances the cost and solicits support during the first phase of the program for training expenses. Minimal tuition is paid by students.

At the second phase, the partner company is the main venue for education.

- 03 Schedule Dualtech Center coordinator(s) to visit the plant to see the work stations of the trainees and meet with counterparts to craft training plan.
- 04 Get MOA, training plan, and other documents signed for TESDA Accreditation.
- 05 Submit the accreditation application documents to TESDA through Dualtech
- 06 Schedule TESDA ocular visit
- 07 Wait for the issuance of TESDA DTS Accreditation Certificate.
- 08 Screen and select trainees
- 09 Start training
