Toyota Smart Logistics Conference 2025

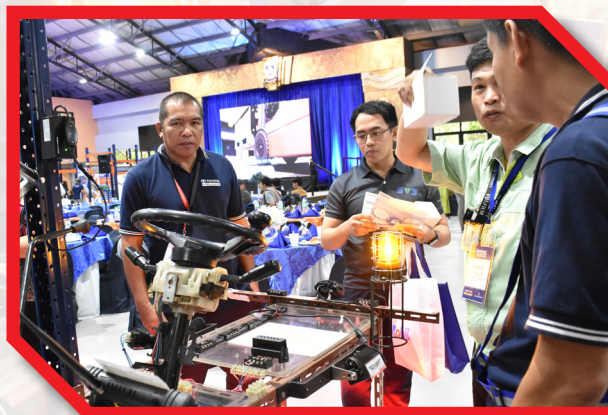


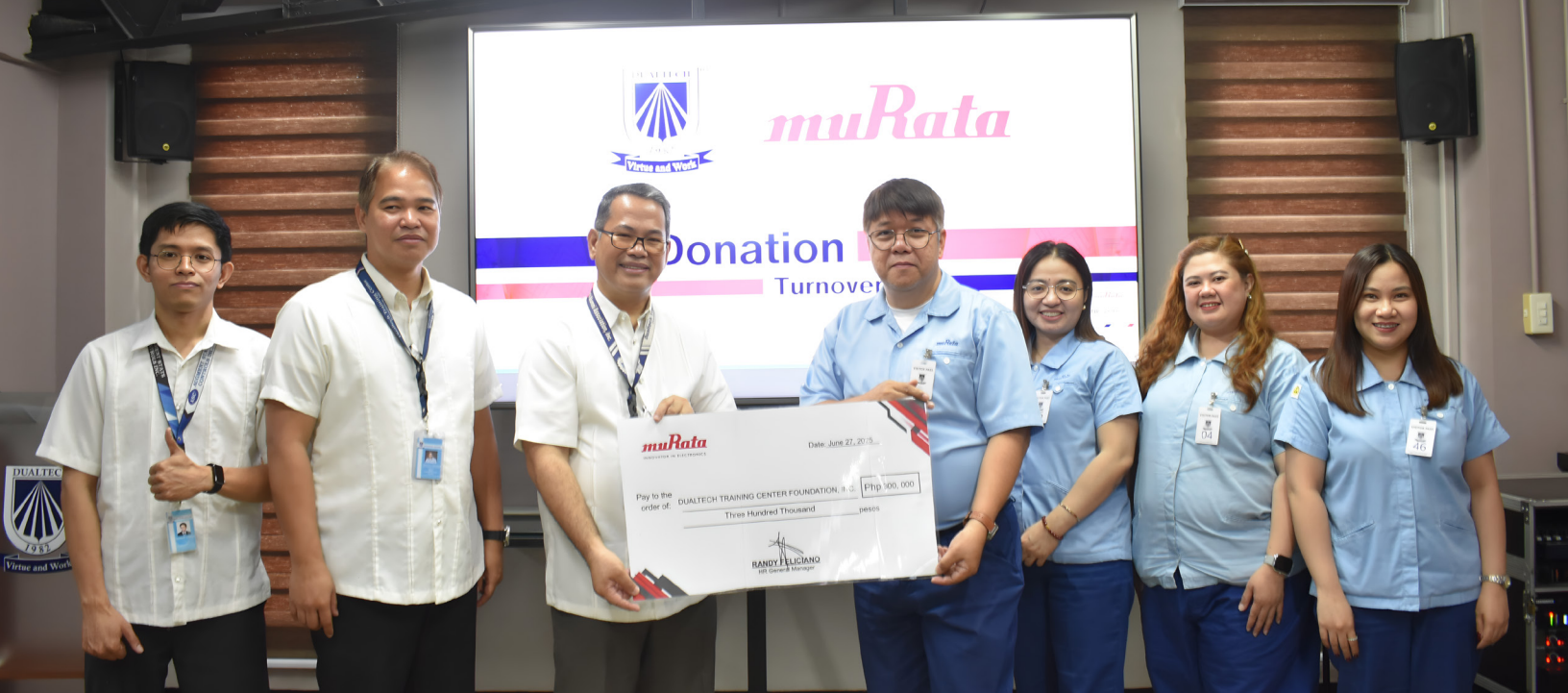

Parents' Formation Seminar on the Value of Education



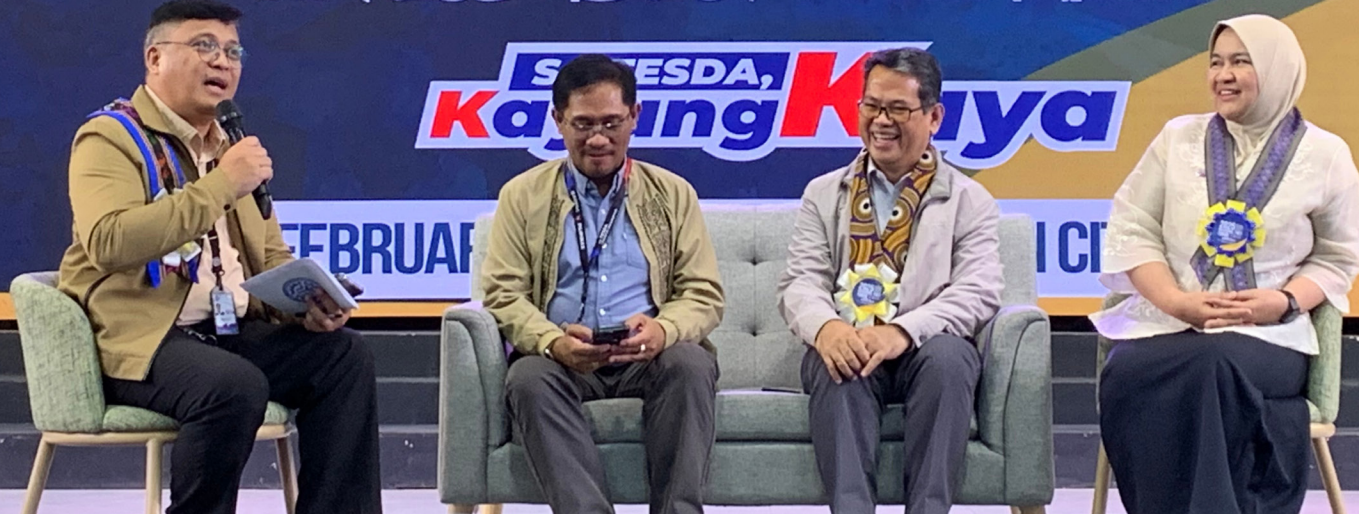

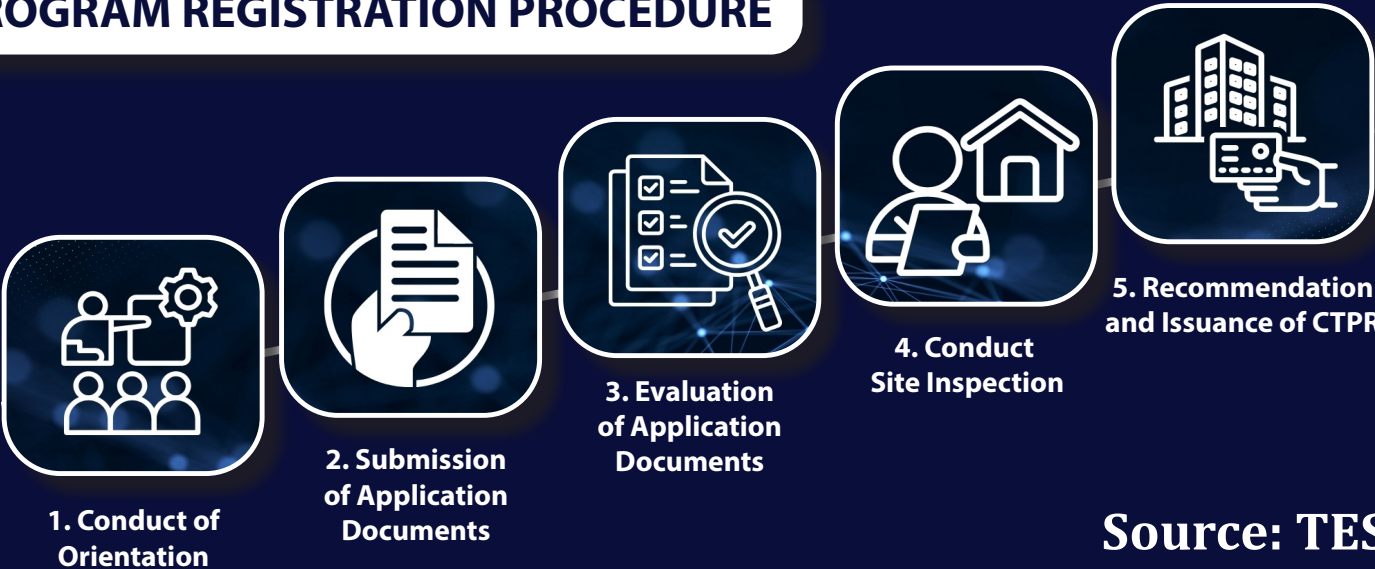

It integrates apprenticeship, learnership, and dual training under a single framework to address job-skills mismatches, enhance workforce competitiveness, and link education directly with industry needs, promoting collaboration between TESDA, TVET institutions, and the private sector.

Enterprise-Academe Collaboration through the EBET Program

In line with Dualtech's continuing efforts to strengthen enterprise-academe collaboration through the Enterprise-Based Education and Training (EBET) program, courtesy visits, consultations, and partnership activities were conducted with TESDA regional and provincial offices and industry partners across different areas.

Dualtech conducted courtesy visits to TESDA offices in CAR; Benguet; Nueva Vizcaya; Region III, including Pampanga and Zambales; Cavite; Batangas; Rizal; Region VI; Region X, including Misamis Oriental and Misamis Occidental; Region XI, including Davao de Oro; Region XII (SOCCSKSARGEN), including SarGen; and the Zamboanga Peninsula. These engagements strengthened collaboration with TESDA offices nationwide to facilitate the registration and implementation of the apprenticeship program among industry partners.

Dualtech Center, in collaboration with TESDA Laguna, hosted an Industry Forum on the Enterprise-Based Education and Training (EBET) Framework Act (Republic Act No. 12063). Dualtech also supported TESDA NCR and TESDA Cavite in inviting partner enterprises to transition from the Dual Training System to EBET. The forum gathered industry partners to discuss key provisions of the law aimed at developing a more competent and industry-ready Filipino workforce.

In addition, Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) were signed with TESDA Region III and TESDA Region XI, further reinforcing the shared commitment to the implementation of the EBET program.

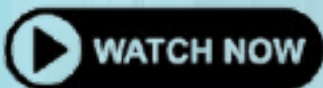
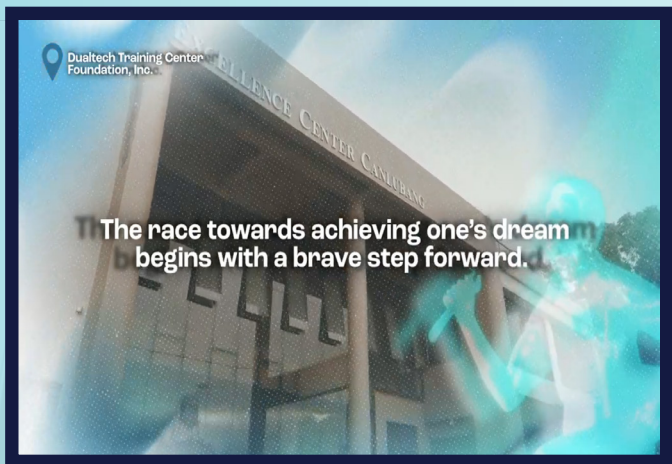
